BUFFER ZONES FOR ELECTIONEERING

Buffer zones are designated in accordance with General Statute 163-166.4(a), by the Madison County Board of Elections. Where practical, the set limit of the zone is 50 feet from the door of entrance to the voting place, measured when that door is closed, but in no event is the limit more than 50 feet or at less than 25 feet.

The poll workers will mark buffer zones on Election Day with special election cones, signage, and/or yellow tape. Maps of Buffer Zones will be available at the polling places and viewable on the Madison County Board of Elections website.
